Rep. Kauffman Elected to Vice Chair at CSG West

BOISE, Idaho – Idaho House Republican Caucus member Representative Clark Kauffman will be the next Vice Chair of the Council of State Governments West (CSG West). The Nominating Committee's 12 members interviewed Kauffman on July 17th at CSG West's annual meeting. The Executive Committee accepted the Nominating Committee's recommendation two days later. Kauffman's term starts in January with the expectation that he will become chair in 2022.

"I am humbled and honored by the election," said Rep. Kauffman. "I am looking forward to helping to lead this organization that serves the West, its legislators, and its people."
