Idaho House Republican Caucus Joins with Governor Little to Further Cut Regulatory Burdens and Reduce Government Oversight

BOISE, Idaho – The Idaho House Republican Caucus leadership joined Governor Brad Little in his office today for a joint news conference to declare their continued efforts to cut Idaho’s administrative rules.

This year the Idaho legislature with the Governor has already cut and simplified 40-percent of Idaho’s administrative rules.

“Great work has already taken place and we are committed to do much more. An overhaul of the regulations will help ensure that businesses are not being burdened with unnecessary and antiquated regulations,” House Speaker Scott Bedke said. “We are a model for other states in achieving the largest regulatory cuts in Idaho’s history.”
