New Working Group to Help Provide Property Tax Relief

BOISE, Idaho – The Idaho House Republican Caucus is pleased to announce a new legislative working group to study the current property tax structure in the state, and better understand the complexities of the process. Four members of the Republican Caucus are part of the group, including Majority Leader Mike Moyle, Rep. Robert Anderst, Rep. Rodney G. “Rod” Furniss, and Rep. Gary Collins, who will chair the group.

“Idahoans need property tax relief, and this group’s mission is to figure out how to give it to them,” said Chairman Collins. “This state’s property taxes are some of the highest in the nation. It’s not fair, and it puts our working families at a disadvantage. We’ll work to find ways to fix that.”

The working group will also develop strategies to create greater transparency in the process, encourage economic development, meet the needs of local units of government and answer the concerns over rising property taxes.
