Caucus Continues Working for Tax Relief

BOISE, Idaho – Your Idaho House Republican Caucus continues to heed the call from across the state to provide tax relief to overburdened Idaho families. Today, on the floor of the House of Representatives, caucus members amended a bill in order to increase the homeowner tax exemption from \$100,000 to \$112,000.

“Every budget increase that’s being shouldered by hard-working Idahoans through their skyrocketing property taxes has been set through local action,” said Speaker of the House Scott Bedke. “The Legislature doesn’t collect or set property tax or even approve budgets that are funded with property tax. But this is one of the most critical issues affecting our constituents, so we had to do something to help.”

With the Senate voting down a House bill that would’ve frozen property taxes, this became the last option for the caucus to provide some desperately needed property tax relief.
